

It is the prayer of the Deacons and Staff of Rehoboth Missionary Baptist Church that you receive this letter in the spirit of love and unity in which it is written. We are very concerned with the recent and ongoing controversy with Grace Truth Church and its effect on the TEBA, its Churches, as well as, the people of God in our communities. We humbly believe that reconciliation is not only called for but is also possible. Therefore, after much prayer, after several conversations between you and our Senior Pastor Gary Few (at least 5); after the last meeting of the Executive Committee of the TEBA, and after several conversations with the leadership at GTC; we feel, based on God's Word (James 4:11, 2 Corinthians 5:18, Romans 15:5, etc.), that you and the Credentials Committee need to apologize in writing (signed by all who sent the letter) to GTC, as well as, to all the TEBA churches that received the April 22nd letter, for the misrepresentation of GTC in the before mentioned letter labeling them (GTC) as "hyper-Calvinistic", a term in which you now believe to be as inaccurate. We feel this apology will begin the process of reconciliation, as well as, begin the process of healing some hurt brothers and sisters in Christ. This letter is not intended to debate doctrine or theology or to choose sides. This letter simply states that our desire is to be a beacon of hope in our community and to help bring reconciliation and healing to those hurt. We would like to hear a response back from you before September 18th, 2013 as we prayerfully consider our next course of action.
